This road scheme has many flaws, which were pointed out to OCC on numerous occasions. Instead of looking at ways to update and improve the scheme, our comments were ignored.

The rejection of the scheme by a good majority should have been enough to make OCC stop and rethink.

Our village of Appleford stands out as being one of the worst hit by the building of this road.

It will be a permanent blight overlooking the village, creating noise, light and air pollution which is unhealthy and unacceptable.

A road may be necessary, and this isn't just "nimbyism", but our efforts to move the road away from the immediate vicinity of the village have been ignored.
