**PROPOSED NETWORK RAIL (LEEDS TO MICKLEFIELD
ENHANCEMENTS) ORDER APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE UNDER
SECTION 19 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981 (THE 1981 ACT)**

- 1 I refer to your email of 22 December about the above application for a certificate under section 19(1) (b) and paragraph 6(1)(a) of Schedule 3 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 and enclose a copy of a notice of the Secretary of State for Levelling Up Housing & Communities intention to give the certificate in accordance with the provisions of section 19(2) and Schedule 3, paragraph 6(3).
- 2 In exercise of his powers under section 19(2) and (2A) of and paragraph 6(3) and (3A) of Schedule 3 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, the Secretary of State for Levelling Up Housing & Communities directs Network Rail to give public notice of his intention to give a certificate in the following manner:

(a) by publishing the attached notice ("the notice") for two successive weeks in the local newspaper or newspapers in which notice under section 11 of the making of the compulsory purchase order was published;

(b) by posting copies of the notice in the vicinity of the land mentioned in it ("the land") and in the usual places where it is customary to display notices of Network Rail.

The notice should be completed by inserting the date of publication and the time (not less than 21 days) within which objections or representations may be made; and details of the place where the public may see copies of the order, the order map(s), and a plan showing the order land.

- 3 Copies of the newspaper, or of the page from the newspaper containing the public notice, and of the notice as posted and sent to interested local authorities and to persons who, if the land was being compulsorily purchased, would be entitled to be served with a notice under section 12 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, should be forwarded to this office not later than 2 weeks from the date when the notice was last published.
